The St Georges TRA is a residents association that all residents on the estate can join. Its mission is to give a voice to residents in the running of the estate and to help with social life on the estate. Helping to promote an active and inclusive community life on the estate will be a key part of the TRA's role with the St. Georges Community Hall due to be opened this year.

Every TRA member has the right to attend TRA meetings and to vote on its policies. The TRA is an independent residents association.

The TRA is governed by its Constitution and its Code of Conduct. Both are available to download from its website. The Code of Conduct means that the TRA is based on good practice and good conduct, it encourages resident involvement and access without discrimination, and follows the Council's and the Housing Association's Equal Opportunity policy.

Every year, the TRA will organise an AGM advertised to all residents of St Georges estate. At the AGM, the TRA will submit its annual accounts and all TRA members are allowed to vote on the following year's TRA.

The TRA is in its development phase. Any member can be involved in the TRA development by joining the TRA Working Group. This requires 1 to 2 hours a week and doing the free training on offer. Please check the TRA website or look out for flyers on the estate.
